factor of 7.



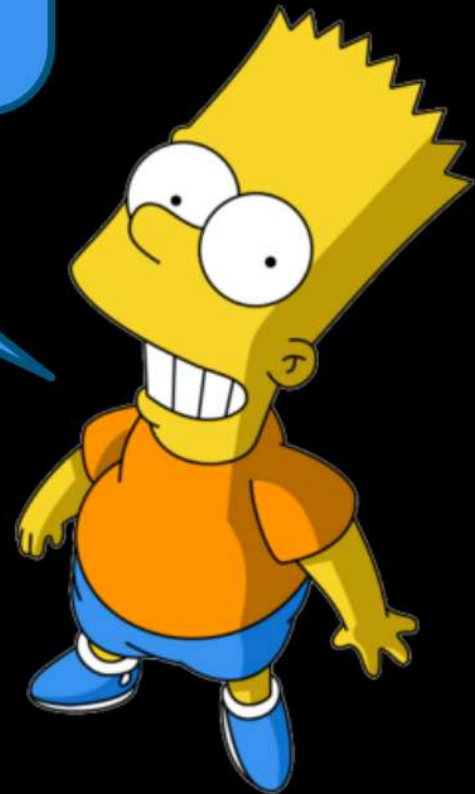
What classic mistake has Jimbo Jones made?

of 15 and 30 is 60.



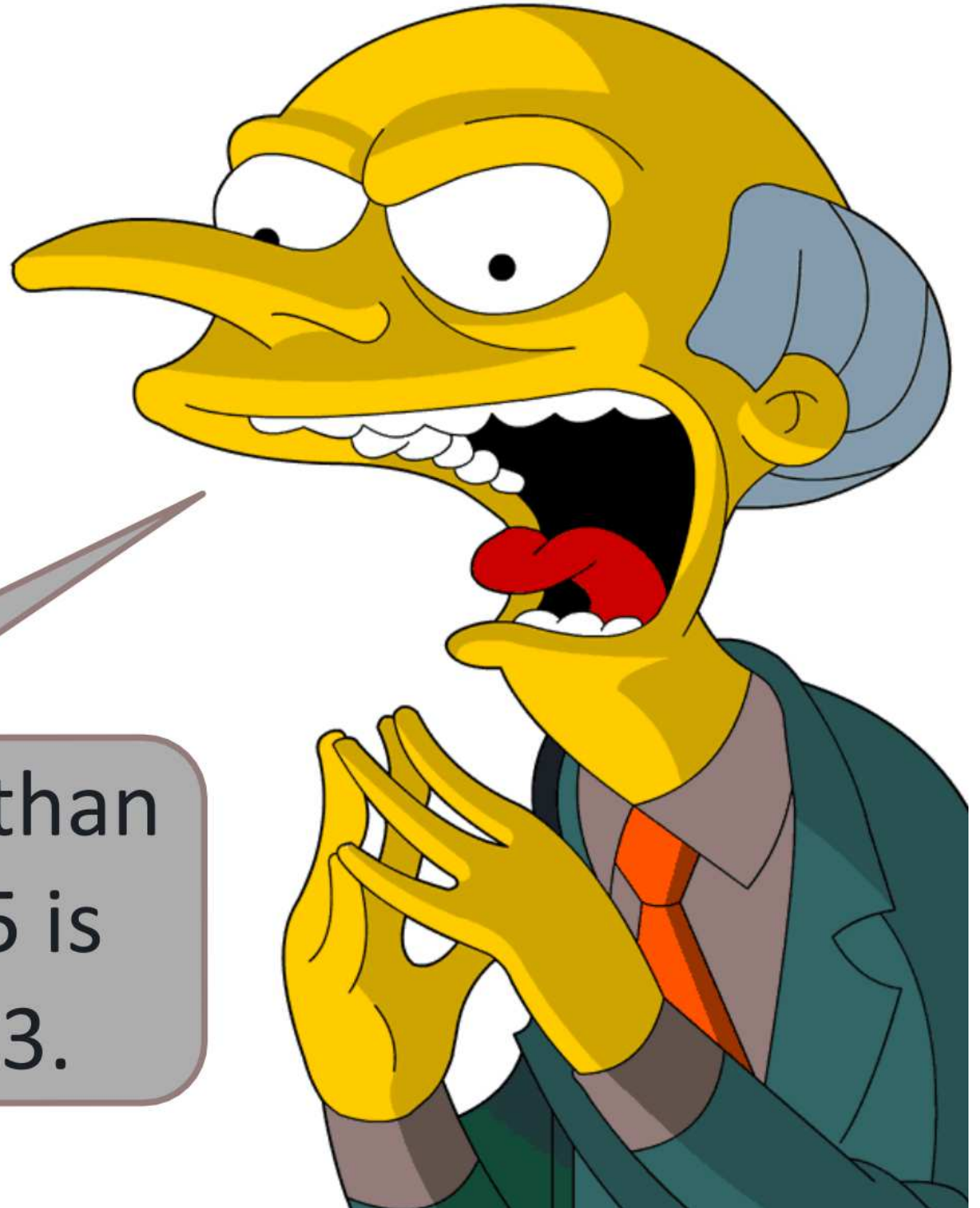
What classic mistake has Milhouse made?
